Usually people use the pink, green and blue. Yellow is too soft, about the same as the bed foam.

The real name of the stuff is Confor-Foam, manufactured by EAR in Indianapolis. Don't bother trying to get it straight from EAR, their minimum order is one full bun - about 4' thick. You need someone that will slice off 1" sheets for you.

For a Cozy, you want one full sheet 1" thick of each of the three colors. Full sheets are their minumum order. A Long EZ only uses half of that.
