

Brake Heat Shields

Robin du Bois - Here's a quick EZ route to heat shields on gear legs. It took me about an hour to make these and about 20 minutes per side to bolt on. The only thing to dismantle is the wheel from the axle and brake. The heat shields slide right on the axle. You hold them where you want them and drill the four holes.

The bends need to be about 45 degrees. None of the dimensions are very critical and the part is EZ to make and install. *Editor note: The CAD drawing was done by a high school drafting student, Mike Ellis. Thanks Mike.*
