

## \$200 Electric Nose Gear

As the years pass and our backs become more sensitive to strain, the EZ nose lifting exercise becomes less easy.

Several years ago John VanDusen, a Michigan Long-EZ builder, designed, built, and installed an electrically actuated nose extension system that would raise a fully loaded EZ up to the taxi position.
