### Best Exterior




Dave and Mabel Haggard of Wichita, Kansas in Long-EZ N412DM.



The photo to the left shows how a gascolator should be safety wired. If the bowl retainer is not secured laterally it can spread and fall out of the attachment holes. This will allow the bowl to fall off starving the carb of fuel and throwing gasoline on the hot engine. Exciting, huh?
