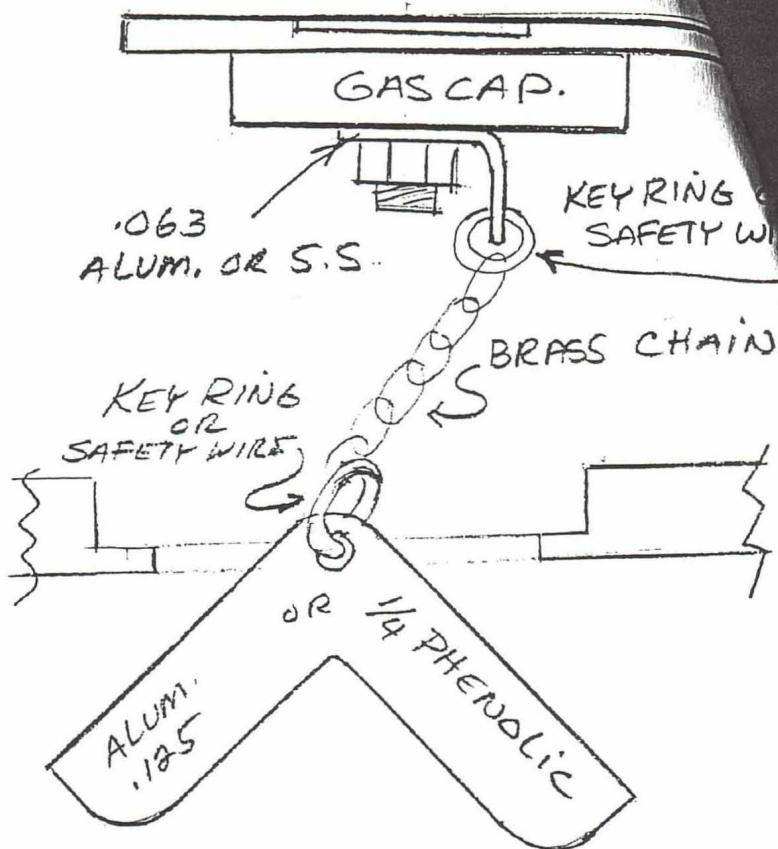


Flying Hockey Pucks and Props.
