the cost, flying a rental airplane to the islands can be almost as cheap as chartering from

Olympic Aviation.

All too soon, Karamichalis determined my flying skills were sufficient to turn me loose. I was grateful for his confidence but sad because my vacation was over the next day, and I knew I wouldn't get a chance to make any flights on my own.

Next time, I'll know to start with an excellent instructor such as Karamichalis. His help and that of my English-speaking friend made the experience of flying in Greece relatively

painless and certainly memorable.
